Ethics: A Higher Calling - 3pm to 4pm

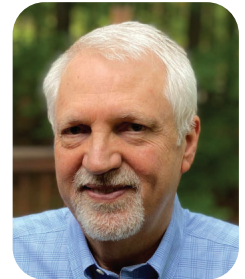
