Medical Emergencies - 9AM to 12PM

Dental teams recognize the importance of proper office and staff preparations for the occasional medical emergency. This topic need not be complex or intimidating for the dental team to provide excellent responsive and supportive care. Refresh yourself and your approach to office medical emergencies by joining us for an updated look into this vital subject.

- -Understand basic techniques for treating medical emergencies
- -Review appropriate roles for staff members during a medical emergency
- -Develop a medical emergency kit for the dental office
