Infection Control - This one-hour continuing education course provides a foundational overview of infection control principles in the dental office, aligned with current CDC guidelines and OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens standards.

- Describe the principles of standard precautions as outlined by the CDC
- Identify common occupational exposure risks addressed under the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard
- Recognize common breaches in infection control

Ethics: Healthcare Screening for Intimate Partner Violence and Human Trafficking: The Role of Dental Professionals

This course provides evidence-based strategies for recognizing warning signs, initiating sensitive conversations, and understanding reporting and referral procedures.
