2021 Utah Giving

In 2021, the Delta Dental Community Care Foundation granted \$120,000 within the state of Utah.

The Foundation partnered with local community organizations to increase access to care, support dental education, fund research that advances the oral health field and respond to disasters or other community needs as they arose.

Utah Partner Spotlight

Since 2002, Southwest Utah Community Health Center (dba Family Healthcare) has been the health care home for more than 15,000 low-income, uninsured and underinsured residents of Washington and Iron counties in rural Utah. Family Healthcare provides integrated medical, dental and behavioral health care in the cities of St. George, Hurricane and Cedar City so patients can receive three types of primary care in one visit. Through the support of the Delta Dental Community Care Foundation, Family Healthcare can offer no-charge dental care for those with the greatest financial need.



Since 2011, the Foundation, the philanthropic arm of Delta Dental of California, has awarded more than \$80 million across 15 states and the District of Columbia in the form of:

Access to care grants are awarded to organizations working to increase access to quality dental care for underserved children, seniors and adults.

Education and research grants provide funding for oral health research and scholarships for students pursuing the dental profession.

Community Giving grants support local nonprofits, including organizations promoting social justice, chronic disease and disaster relief.
