## 2022 Georgia Giving

In 2022, Delta Dental and the Community Care Foundation granted \$667,666 within the state of Georgia.

The Community Care Foundation is committed to building caring, resilient communities by increasing access to oral health care. Since 2011, the Community Care Foundation has dedicated more than \$100 million to improving oral health across its enterprise, including 15 states and Washington, D.C. By investing in the four focus areas below, the Community Care Foundation is helping to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or location, has access to quality oral health care.

Access to Care grants: Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities and drive oral health equity, and promote innovation in the oral health field.

**Senior Oral Health Program:** A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

**Education and research grants:** Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

**Community investments:** Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

## **Georgia Partner Spotlight**

Since 1979, Albany Area Primary Health Center (AAPHC) has been providing Southwest Georgia residents with the highest quality of care and exceptional patient experiences. To further promote healthier oral health outcomes for seniors, AAPHC is leveraging the Community Care Foundation's investment to expand services at the primary care facility in Terrell County to include dental services. In light of reduced services from outside agencies and providers for eligible seniors due to the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as the lifting of dental treatment restrictions, AAPHC plans to increase access to care in order to ensure continued and timely services for all community members.
