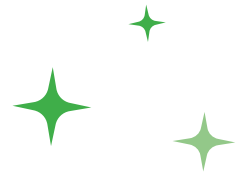

In 2022, Delta Dental and the Community Care Foundation granted \$353,500 within the state of Maryland.

The Community Care Foundation is committed to building caring, resilient communities by increasing access to oral health care. Since 2011, the Community Care Foundation has dedicated more than \$100 million to improving oral health across its enterprise, including 15 states and Washington, D.C. By investing in the four focus areas below, the Community Care Foundation is helping to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or location, has access to quality oral health care.

Access to Care grants: Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities and drive oral health equity, and promote innovation in the oral health field.

Senior Oral Health Program: A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

Education and research grants: Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

Community investments: Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

Maryland Partner Spotlight

As the birthplace of the Doctor of Dental Surgery degree, the University of Maryland School of Dentistry proudly traces its roots to the independent Baltimore College of Dental Surgery, founded in 1840. With grant funding from the Community Care Foundation, the University of Maryland School of Dentistry provides direct patient care and a dental home to approximately 300 undocumented, uninsured or underinsured children in the Baltimore Metropolitan Area.
