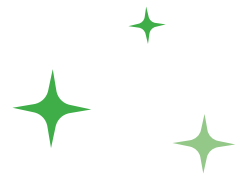

2022 Nevada Giving

In 2022, Delta Dental and the Community Care Foundation granted \$210,000 within the state of Nevada.

The Community Care Foundation is committed to building caring, resilient communities by increasing access to oral health care. Since 2011, the Community Care Foundation has dedicated more than \$100 million to improving oral health across its enterprise, including 15 states and Washington, D.C. By investing in the four focus areas below, the Community Care Foundation is helping to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or location, has access to quality oral health care.

Access to Care grants: Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities and drive oral health equity, and promote innovation in the oral health field.

Senior Oral Health Program: A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

Education and research grants: Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

Community investments: Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

Nevada Partner Spotlight

Founded in 1977, Nevada Health Centers (NVHC) is a Federally Qualified Health Center whose mission is to provide access to quality health care services throughout Nevada. With 18 brick and mortar locations, three operational mobile units, and a fourth mobile unit planned, NVHC core services range from primary care, dental, behavioral health, women's health, pharmacy, and telehealth to reach all counties of Nevada. Community Care Foundation funds help support the purchase of equipment and dental supplies across the three dental facilities and offset the cost of patient services, especially for their senior patients.
