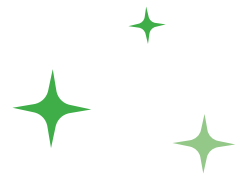

2022 New York Giving

In 2022, Delta Dental and the Community Care Foundation granted \$1,377,691 within the state of New York.

The Community Care Foundation is committed to building caring, resilient communities by increasing access to oral health care. Since 2011, the Community Care Foundation has dedicated more than \$100 million to improving oral health across its enterprise, including 15 states and Washington, D.C. By investing in the four focus areas below, the Community Care Foundation is helping to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or location, has access to quality oral health care.

Access to Care grants: Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities and drive oral health equity, and promote innovation in the oral health field.

Senior Oral Health Program: A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

Education and research grants: Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

Community investments: Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

New York Partner Spotlight

Since 1981, Morris Heights Health Center (MHHC) has had a record of distinction as the major provider of health care to Morris Heights and the surrounding areas of the Bronx in New York City. Born out of the local need for quality care, MHHC has provided quality primary health care services to all members of the community, including the medically, socially and economically disadvantaged. Community Care Foundation funds enable Morris Heights Health Center to support Bronx seniors by increasing their access to oral health care, improving oral health literacy and strengthening the integration of oral health with primary care. MHHC will increase access to oral health care by offering dental screenings and education pop-up clinics throughout the year and provide dentures to low-income patients aged 65 and older.
