## 2022 Texas Giving

In 2022, Delta Dental and the Community Care Foundation granted \$1,386,543 within the state of Texas.

The Community Care Foundation is committed to building caring, resilient communities by increasing access to oral health care. Since 2011, the Community Care Foundation has dedicated more than \$100 million to improving oral health across its enterprise, including 15 states and Washington, D.C. By investing in the four focus areas below, the Community Care Foundation is helping to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or location, has access to quality oral health care.

Access to Care grants: Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities and drive oral health equity, and promote innovation in the oral health field.

**Senior Oral Health Program:** A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

**Education and research grants:** Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

**Community investments:** Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

## **Texas Partner Spotlight**

Community Health Development, Inc. (CHDI) operates the only primary care centers in Real County, Texas, providing care to 46% of the county's population in 2022. CHDI is uniquely positioned to be the premier health care provider in Real County. Unfortunately, due to facility constraints, the sites in Real County were unable to provide the full scope of services that are offered at the agency's main site in Uvalde. With funding from the Community Care Foundation, CHDI has developed the "Expanding Access to Comprehensive Care in Real County" project to create a fully integrated and comprehensive health care solution to prioritize health care needs in Real County.
