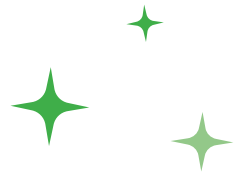




Delta Dental Community Care Foundation



In 2023, Delta Dental and the Community Care Foundation granted **\$250,000** within the state of **Nevada**.

The Delta Dental Community Care Foundation is committed to building caring, resilient communities by increasing access to oral health care. Since 2011, the Foundation has dedicated more than \$150 million to improving oral health across its enterprise, spanning 15 states and Washington, D.C. By investing in the four focus areas outlined below, the Foundation is helping to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or location, has access to quality oral health care.

Access to Care Grants

Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities, drive oral health equity and promote innovation in the oral health field.

Senior Oral Health Program

A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

Education & Research Grants

Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

Community Investments

Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

Nevada Partner Spotlight

Nevada Health Centers (NVHC) has been a primary care lifeline for Nevada's underserved since 1977, operating 18 locations, mobile units, and WIC centers. Their comprehensive services cater to all age groups, with specialized facilities in Las Vegas and Elko. They partner with Ronald McDonald House to provide dental care via a mobile unit for youth. In 2022, NVHC served 4,398 individuals through 11,381 dental visits. With plans for expansion, Delta Dental's support will enhance patient services, equipment, and add two more mobile dental units. This demonstrates NVHC's commitment to providing accessible and high-quality healthcare across Nevada.
