

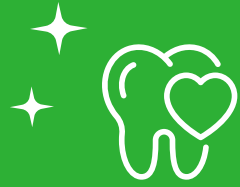

The Delta Dental Community Care Foundation is committed to building caring, resilient communities by increasing access to oral health care.



Since 2011, the Foundation has invested more than \$200 million to improve oral health outcomes across 15 states and Washington, D.C. Guided by four strategic focus areas, the Foundation advances access, equity and innovation to help ensure quality oral health care for all communities.

In 2025, Delta Dental and the Community Care Foundation granted \$1,597,500 within the state of New York.



Access to Care

We fund organizations working to expand access to oral health care, reduce health disparities, advance oral health equity and support innovative approaches that improve outcomes for underserved communities.



Senior Oral Health

A multi-year initiative focused on identifying and addressing the social, economic and systemic factors that contribute to poor oral health among older adults, with the goal of improving access to quality care as people age.



Future of Dentistry

We support partnerships with universities and dental schools to strengthen the education, training and inclusiveness of the future oral health workforce.



Community Investments

We invest in local organizations advancing health equity, social justice and community resilience, including support for disaster response and recovery efforts.
