Since 2011, the Foundation has dedicated more than \$150 million to improving oral health across its enterprise, spanning 15 states and Washington, D.C. By investing in the four focus areas outlined below, the Foundation is helping to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or location, has access to quality oral health care.

Access to Care Grants

Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities, drive oral health equity and promote innovation in the oral health field.

Education & Research Grants

Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

Senior Oral Health Program

A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

Community Investments

Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

Florida Partner Spotlight

Wounded Veterans Relief Fund (WVRF) initially served disabled veterans in Palm Beach County and expanded statewide in 2016. Covering all eight VA medical center regions in Florida, WVRF offers emergency financial assistance to veterans in housing, transportation, and other essential areas. Despite many veterans qualifying for VA financial aid, the lengthy processing time hinders immediate responses to emergencies like eviction or job loss. With Delta



Dental's support, WVRF extends its services to provide urgent dental care for disabled veterans ineligible for VA dental coverage, which is limited to those with a 100% disability rating or a service-related oral injury. This initiative addresses the critical oral health needs of veterans facing urgent situations.
