Access to Care Grants

Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities, drive oral health equity and promote innovation in the oral health field.

Education & Research Grants

Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

Senior Oral Health Program

A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

Community Investments

Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

Harlem United, founded during the HIV Crisis in the 1980s, is committed to eradicating health disparities by offering inclusive, holistic care. Serving marginalized populations like communities of color and the unstably housed, they focus on healthcare, housing, harm reduction, and supportive services. Their healthcare program, including federally qualified health centers and mobile units, provides primary, specialty, mental health, and dental care. Harlem United empowers individuals to access multiple services to improve overall health, aiming for positive outcomes and saving lives. With Delta Dental's support, they acquired, installed, and evaluated digital intraoral scanners, bolstering efforts to address oral health disparities and enhance their comprehensive approach to care.
