Since 2011, the Foundation has dedicated more than \$150 million to improving oral health across its enterprise, spanning 15 states and Washington, D.C. By investing in the four focus areas outlined below, the Foundation is helping to ensure that everyone, regardless of their background or location, has access to quality oral health care.

Access to Care Grants

Fund organizations working to increase access to care, address health disparities, drive oral health equity and promote innovation in the oral health field.

Education & Research Grants

Support our partnerships with universities to increase inclusiveness in the education and development of future dental professionals.

Senior Oral Health Program

A multi-year initiative to identify, assess and address the socioeconomic and systemic causes of poor oral health among older adults.

Community Investments

Focus on supporting local organizations through health equity, social justice and disaster relief efforts.

Texas Partner Spotlight

North Central Texas Community Health Care Center (CHC) has been committed to providing accessible, high-quality, patient-centered primary and preventive healthcare services in Wichita County since 1994. With a vision to eliminate health disparities, CHC has evolved from a 3,800 SF facility to state-of-the-art facilities with 12 clinic sites, serving over 31,000 patients annually.

In 2023, new clinic locations in Plano and Wilbarger expanded services.

CHC offers comprehensive dental services with a sliding fee scale based on income, ensuring affordability. Utilizing an internal referral system, they connect patients with low-cost health-care across medical, dental, behavioral, and OB/GYN services. Delta Dental's support enables the use of teledentistry services to enhance access for restorative and preventive care, diagnostic testing, and tooth extraction for those facing financial barriers.
